

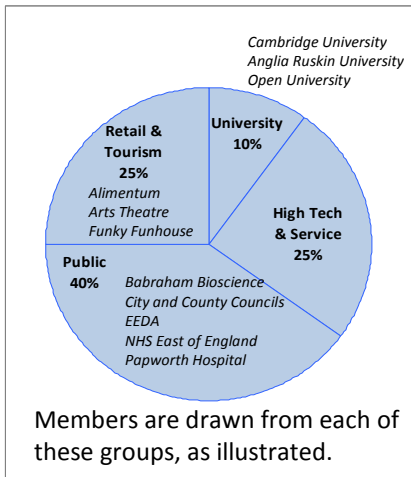

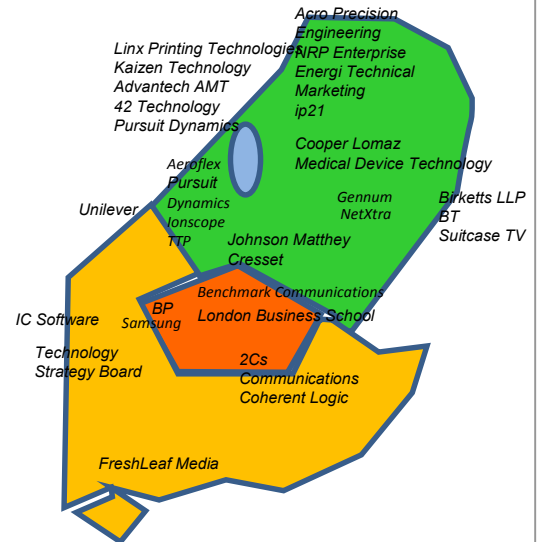
##### Cambridge postcode employers shown by %

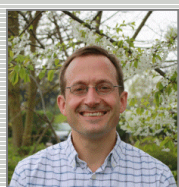
